Agreed Actions Moving Forward

These apply to all shows in the future and should be reviewed annually and amended if necessary

- Provide a free and inclusive Refreshment break at all rehearsals
- Ensure members are better informed/advance notice of all rehearsals where possible
- A consistent approach to special events
- Outline the structure on supporting Stage Crew where members are requested to help
- Consider members on run up to show week keep one evening free where possible
- Outline to members the Society's expectation that they have a personal responsibility to ensure their health and wellbeing in order to deliver consistent performances during show week.
- The Committee will drive the production and inform members of heads of departments so questions can be directed to the right person and not overload the Director, MD and Choreographer.
- Ensure rehearsals are more organised: better disciplined, more organised seating for singing rehearsals enabling identification of parts e.g. sops, altos etc.
- Acknowledge importance of warm ups but lessen the time spent on activities or introduce some already set dances/sequences/music.
